


INTERNATIONAL IMPLANT CARD

Instruction for completion: Fill in...

- Name and surname of the patient (or patient ID)
- Date of implantation
- Name and address of the healthcare institution/ provider that performed the implantation
- Name of the implanted medical device
- Catalogue number of the manufacturer
- Lot number of the manufacturer
- Unique Device Identifier

For sterile products: Use our **sticker:** You can find the patient label either inside or on the back of the product packaging, as the design may vary depending on the date of manufacture.
